IV. Adoption of Meeting Agendum

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to adopt the meeting agendum as written with Prescheduled Appearance #2 going first. Motion carried 6-0.

V. Approval of Meeting Minutes

A. Tuesday, February 21, 2017, Meeting Minutes

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve the February 21, 2017, minutes as written. Motion carried 6-0.

VI. Courtesies of the Floor

A. Pre-Scheduled Appearances

1. Stephanie Mindler, Junior Troop 8860- Presentation of Project for Bronze Award

Junior Troop 8860- We would like to build a Gaga pit in Dimmick Park or Water Street Park to earn our Bronze Award which is the highest award a Junior can earn. It is similar to dodge ball but the ball is thrown at the feet. The pit is made of wood and is a 20' x 22' octagon.

Mr. McKenna suggested that it be placed at Authority Park.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve the project and have them work with staff to make sure it is secure and completed properly. The Girl Scouts will be responsible for maintenance of the pit. Motion carried 6-0.

2. Larry Brisman, Beyer-Barber- Discussion on Police Pension Plan 2018 MMO

Mr. Brisman- The 2017 actuarial study has been completed and beginning in 2018 ,with current employer, employee, and state aid received, the Borough is left with an approximate \$37,000.00 shortfall. The Borough could utilize the asset smoothing method which would result in a greater credit.

Mr. Rieger- As of July 1, 2017, the Borough will lose two full-time police officers because of the lack of casino funds. Some other municipalities have had issues with using the smoothing method. I would like to see the actuarial study completed with the known numbers from the recently signed contract.

Herbert Payung- The Police Pension Board did not recommend smoothing either. In 2004, the disability amount was raised to 75 percent. Three officers have gone on retirement and disability. If another officer goes out, I would believe that would make the pension fund underfunded.

It was the consensus of Council to rerun the actuarial study using the current payroll numbers and to not utilize the smoothing method.

The Water Street Bridge Replacement Project will now include a 3 foot shoulder on each side of the bridge with a 5 foot sidewalk on north side. That sidewalk will connect with Creek Road.

All construction easements have been executed and forwarded to PennDOT for the local bridge project.

X. New Business

1. Outstanding Obligations- Approval of Payments

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve the payments. Motion carried 6-0.

2. Adoption of Ordinance 811, Medical Marijuana- Council Action

Mr. Corriere- In Pennsylvania, it is now legal to dispense medical marijuana. This ordinance was adopted from the model ordinance

provided by the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission. It outlines regulations of dispensaries, clinical research centers, vehicle transport, and processing centers.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to amend the ordinance to include dispensaries in the mixed district and processing into the industrial district. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Herbert Payung, to adopt Ordinance 811 with amendments. Motion carried 6-0.

3. Adoption of Ordinance 813, Amendments to Zoning Ordinance-  
Council Action

Mr. Corriere- This amendment provided definitions for some items that were not defined by our current ordinance.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to adopt Ordinance 813. Motion carried 6-0.

4. Adoption of Ordinance 814, Wireless Communication Facilities-  
Council Action

Mr. Corriere- The Borough hired an outside firm with knowledge in the changing regulations of cell towers and mini towers to review and update our ordinance. The mini tower would be a permitted use on the designated streets by obtaining a special exception.

Mrs. Hartranft- There is also a section that discusses mini cell towers that are now being placed in right-of-ways in other municipalities.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Herbert Payung, to adopt Ordinance 814. Motion carried 6-0.

5. Adoption of Resolution 17-05, Designation of Road for Wireless  
Communication Facilities- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- It was recommended to outline the areas where the mini cell towers can be placed by resolution. The towers can go by

special exception onto the follow roads: Walnut Street, Main Street, portion of Water Street, portion of Durham Street, and portion of High Street.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Philip Weber, to - adopt Resolution 17-05. Motion carried 6-0.

6. Authorization to Advertise Ordinance 817, Abandoned Vehicles- Council Action

Mr. Corriere- Mrs. Hartranft, Chief Shupp, and I worked to revise the ordinance to cover both junked and abandoned vehicles to try and address some issue around the Borough.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to advertise Ordinance 817. Motion carried 6-0.

7. Authorization to Send Outstanding 2016 Borough Real Estate Taxes to Northampton County Tax Claim- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- We will be sending just under \$65,000.00 to Northampton County Tax Claim.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to send outstanding Real Estate Taxes to Northampton County Tax Claim. Motion carried 6-0.

Mrs. Hartranft- We will also be sending approximately \$43,000.00 to collections for unpaid Sanitation and Recycling bills and placing liens on the 2015 bills that remain unpaid.

8. Authorization to Advertise:

a) 2017 Seal Coating Bid

b) 2017 Road Paving Bid

Mrs. Hartranft- The streets for the 2017 Seal Coating and Paving Project are as follows: Wilson Avenue, Miller Street, Spruce

Street, Detweiler Avenue, New Jersey Avenue, Phillips Street, and Jefferson Street.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, advertise 2017 Seal Coating and Road Paving Bids. Motion carried 6-0.

9. Discussion on Adding a Stop Intersection at Bachman and Whitaker Streets- Council Action

Chief Shupp- We received a letter from a concerned resident about the intersection at Bachman and Whitaker Streets where the Rail Trail entrance is located. Since there is no stop, cars are rounding the corner while people are crossing to get on the trail. Our recommendation would be to install a stop sign on Bachman Street. The resident will lose a parking space in front of her house but she is aware of that fact and will park on Whitaker Street.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to install a stop sign and stopbar at the end of Bachman Street. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to advertise amendment to the road and sign ordinance. Motion carried 6-0.

10. Appointment of Joe Pampanin to Compost Center Committee- Council Action

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Philip Weber, to appoint Joe Pampanin to the Compost Center Committee. Motion carried 6-0.

11. Approval of Request for Handicap Parking Space at 1630 Riegel Street- Council Action

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve handicap parking space at 1630 Riegel Street. Motion carried 6-0.

12. Approval of Step Increase for Jake Yonney to Truck Driver II-  
Council Action

Mr. Henshaw- Mr. Yonney has met all requirements and passed the written test.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve the step increase. Motion carried 6-0.

13. Approval of Proposal from Don Werkheiser Electric to Provide Labor and Materials for Dimmick Pavilion Lighting- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- At the last Council meeting, Mr. Werkheiser presented Council with a proposal to replace the lighting at the pavilion with LED rope lighting. The cost estimate is \$1,467.77. The money for the lighting could come out of the grant funding but, I will need a motion from Council.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Earl Hill, to award the contract to Don Werkheiser Electric in an amount not to exceed \$1,467.77. Motion carried 6-0.

14. Approval of 2017 Saucon Valley Lacrosse User's Agreement- Council Action

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Philip Weber, to approve the 2017 Saucon Valley Lacrosse User's Agreement. Motion carried 6-0.

15. Approval of Request from Saucon Valley PTO for Pool Pass Donation- Council Action

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to approve a pool pass donation to Saucon Valley PTO. Motion carried 6-0.

16. Approval of Street Banner Request Form for Saucon Valley Gem Show- Council Action

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve contingent upon staff approval and availability. Motion carried 6-0.



17. Interviews with Council Candidates

One candidate appeared for the position.

Jonathan Lentz is a physical therapist with Lehigh Valley Hospital. He lives in town with his wife and two daughters. He is able to serve on committees and would like to focus on the park system and Main Street revitalization.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to appoint Jonathan Lentz to the open council seat with a term expiring 12/31/17. Motion carried 6-0.

Mr. Corriere advised that the Executive Session was being held to discuss personnel matters.


Council reconvened from Executive Session at 8:45 p.m. Mr. Corriere reiterated that the Executive Session was held to discuss personnel matters.

## February 2017

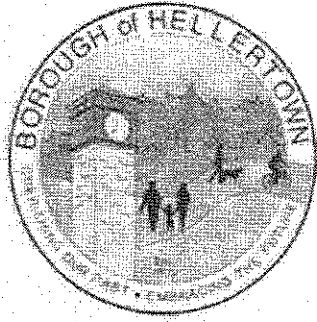
This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from February 1st through February 28th, 2017.

During the month of February the Police received 336 calls for service. We did receive 1 Theft, 4 Domestic/Assault, 1 Sex Offense and 10 traffic collision calls. We wrote 76 citations.

The Police Department filed 15 charges including 2 for Narcotics Possession, 5 for DUI, 4 for Theft and Receiving Stolen Property and 1 for Sexual Assault.
