Mr. Hanner- There are many dogs around Hellertown that are not being leashed. My dog has been attacked 3 times last year and twice this year. I would like to see more enforcement.

Chief Shupp- The Police Department will post information on Facebook. This enforcement will be across the board and would include all parks and events. Violators would be cited.

Mr. Rieger- Do we change the park rule and require all dogs be leashed at Dimmick Park rather than banned?

Mr. Rieger- The Concert in the Park series is going very well.

B. Mayor

Mayor Heintzelman- There is a Bike Ride with the Police tomorrow night at 6:00 p.m. Registration begins at 5:30 p.m. and bike safety will be reviewed. There will be ice cream following the ride.

There have been statements regarding the police department not following up on fire work complaints. Only three incidents were reported to county dispatch. There has been a lot of firework debris that has been left behind by people both in the street and on private property. People are required to be 150 feet from an occupied structure.

Chief Shupp- We have been issuing citations under our nuisance ordinance since the 2018 Crimes Code does not address fireworks enforcement. The City of Easton took the new act that was created and made it their ordinance. I would like it to be specific about the fines and penalties. Borough Council can suspend the ordinance at any time.

Mr. Rieger would like to see times specified in the ordinance unless permitted by the Borough and also to ban the use on any public rightof-way or street.

Staff will work on creating an ordinance to be discussed at the next meeting.

Mayor Heintzelman- The Police Department will have a Crime Watch presentation at 950 Front Street on July 19, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. and again on July 25, 2018, at 650 Northampton Street at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Smith- DCED is accepting applications for a multi-modal grant. This round does not require a match. We suggest applying for improvements to the south end of the Borough. The project would include a connection from rail trail with a bridge over the mill race through Tumminello Park, sidewalk repair, and traffic signal at Polk Valley Road and Main Street. It would create a safe path from the Rail Trail to the Shoppes at Hellertown. We have the project estimated at \$756,470.00 if Council wishes us to pursue the application. A resolution would need to be signed by Council tonight.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to authorize the application to DCED for multi-modal funds and to also authorize Mr. Rieger to execute resolution. Motion carried 6-1 (James Hill opposed).

Mr. Smith- We had a meeting with PennDOT for ARLE grant to provide pedestrian countdowns at the existing traffic signals. Construction will probably be in 2019.

June Rose- They poured the sidewalk near my shop on Water Street. I asked the contractor why they are waiting on making it ADA compliant.

Mr. Smith- PennDOT will be installing the handicap ramps next year when they pave Water Street after the bridge replacement.
