A. Pre-Scheduled Appearances

1. Jessica O'Donnell, Lehigh Valley Chamber- Discussion on Light-Up Night

Ms. O'Donnell- The Light-Up Committee would like to suggest moving Light-Up Night to Dimmick Park. We would like to add more vendors and provide adult beverages. The event would be November 23, 2018.

Mrs. Hartranft- informed Council additional lighting and amenities would be needed at Dimmick Park that Council has not budgeted. Mrs. Hartranft and Mr. Henshaw will review the park area and provide additional recommendations at the next Light Up Committee meeting.

2. Diane Shruntz and Joe Rasich- Request for Waiver of Sidewalk Installation at 1702 Clauser Street.

Mr. Russo- The perspective buyers of 1702 Clauser are looking for a waiver of installation of sidewalks on the entire frontage of the property. There are no curbs or sidewalks currently. Freedom Landscaping was required to put sidewalk in next to this property.

Mrs. Hartranft- I would recommend installing the sidewalk in fromt of the home and to defer the rest until the rest of the road is improved.

The Borough will mark out the paved cartway for Clauser Street from the south side of Kichline Street to Hemlock Street so the owner can pave the road to Borough specifications. Ms. Shruntz and Mr. Rasich will provide the Borough an escrow of \$5,000.00. Motion carried 6-0.

Gary Hillegass, 1690 Riegel Street- I am having issues with people staying at the hotel across the street and parking in front of our home. We are not the only residents having an issue. We are continuously picking up litter in our yards. I spoke with the hotel manager and was told that it is a public street.

Mr. Rieger recommending speaking with the City of Bethlehem about the issue and to also look into creating a draft ordinance regarding adding permitted/zoned parking at the north end of town.

Mr. Rieger did receive recordings of the noise from the property owners at 660 Main Street and will forward onto Council.

Chief Shupp- Currently, the excessive noise is at the police discretion. In prior revisions, Council removed the decimal reading requirements. I would recommend that it not be made a separate ordinance.

XII. Interview Candidates to Fill Council Vacancy

1. Andrew Hughes

Mr. Hughes moved to Hellertown two years ago. He recently switched jobs and has more time to devote to the community. To him, the biggest challenge facing Hellertown is funding and getting money into the community. He wouldn't be sure at this point if he

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would run for election at the end of this term but would fill this term to its conclusion.

2. Michael McKenna

Mr. McKenna has lived in Hellertown for 24 years. His wife will be finishing her licensing classes, which is why he didn't run for reelection, so he will have time to give to Borough Council. He is currently the Assistant Treasurer of the Hellertown Borough Authority and the Vice-Present of the Dewey Fire Company and was a past Borough Councillor. To him, the biggest challenges facing Borough Council are pedestrian safety and stormwater management. There are good plans in place for pedestrian safety but would like to continue with the stormwater management. Mr. McKenna indicated that if he was chosen, he would run for re-election at the end of this term.

3. Larry O'Donnell

Mr. O'Donnell moved to Hellertown about 7 years ago and is involved with the Friends of the Hellertown Area Library as the President of the organization. He describes himself as very organized and structured. He feels that he has the time to invest into Borough Council and would resign his post on the Friends of the Hellertown Area Library Board should he be chosen. The biggest issue he sees facing Hellertown is that there is a bit of a generation gap and that more technology should be used to engage the younger generation.

4. Richard Montalvo

Mr. Montavlo withdrew his name from contention.
