### A. Pre-Scheduled Appearances

1. Jesse Repash, Hellertown Lions- Presentation of Check to Hellertown Police Department

Mr. Repash- The Hellertown Lions began the Support Law Enforcement sign program late last summer. We determined that the Lions would donate the proceeds of the sign purchases to the Hellertown Police and Lower Saucon Township Police. The program will be ongoing.

2. Joshua Malik, Joshua Tree, Inc.- Discussion on Effects of Emerald Ash Borer

Arborist are finding trunk injections have a better success rate than spraying and is more environmentally friendly. Treatments would only need to be done every other year. Treatment does not necessarily need to be this year but Council should work on a 2-3 year plan.

- 3. Discussion, Review, and Authorization to Advertise
  - i. Ordinance 811, Amending the Zoning Ordinance Establishing the Process and Standards to Allow Medical Marijuana Facilities

Mr. Corriere- This ordinance outlines the four categories of facilities. Each must meet the parking requirements and dispensaries cannot be within 1000 feet of a school or daycare.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Herbert Payung, to advertise Ordinance 811. Motion carried 5-1 (Mr. Hill voted no and Mr. Rieger was not present for the motion.)

ii. Ordinance 812, Amending the Current Street Excavation Ordinance to Provide for Pavement Restoration for Utility Work in Borough Streets.

Mr. Corriere- The PennDOT regulations were used in creating this Ordinance. If the hole is more than 100 linear feet, the street must be repaired within 90 days.

Motion made by John Bate, seconded by Earl Hill, to advertise Ordinance 812. Motion carried 7-0.

iii. Ordinance 813, Amending the Zoning Ordinance, Adding Definitions and Uses, and the SALDO to Provide for a Time of Payment for Recreation Fees

Mr. Corriere- The Ordinance gives definition for what constitutes a unit in nursing home, defines a hospital, and clarifies the definition of bank to include a drive-through.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to advertise Ordinance 813. Motion carried 7-0.

4. Authorization to Advertise Bid for Dimmick Park Upgrades- Council Action

Mr. Smith- The Borough received a partial grant for upgrades to the Dimmick Park Pavilion which include replacing the roof and the asphalt pavement with concrete. The soffit repair will need to be done if Council wants to replace the electric and lighting.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by James Hill, to advertise the Dimmick Park Upgrade Bid. Motion carried 7-0.

Mr. Smith and Mr. Henshaw will obtain quotes to replace the lighting.

5. Approval of Job Description for Fire Marshall- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- Our past Fire Marshall resigned and when looking into a replacement we discovered that the position was never officially created. Mr. Russo, Chief Shupp, and myself met with Bill Hillenbrand from the County. He noted that the Fire Marshall is really an assistant to the State Fire Marshall. The position would fall under the codes department and they would report directly to Council.

Staff was thinking of having Mr. Russo fill the position as he already has all but one training course and is present for any fire to check the structure for damage. This would be separate from his Zoning duties.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by John Bate, to direct the Solicitor to draft the necessary ordinance to incorporate the job description. Motion carried 7-0.

### HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

### November 2016

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from November 1st through November 30th, 2016.

During the month of November the Police received 329 calls for service. We did receive 4 Theft, 6 Domestic/Assault, 1 Fraud/Counterfeiting, 1 Burglary, 1 Motor Vehicle Theft, and 10 traffic collision calls. We wrote 87 citations.

The Police Department filed 24 charges including 10 for Narcotics Possession, 6 for DUI, 3 for Theft and Receiving Stolen Property, 1 for Transmission of sexually explicit material and 1 for Forgery.

November was an average month for us this year. We have been doing a lot of work from our PWI arrests last month and gathering a lot of useful information regarding narcotics dealing around town. We have been seeing an increase in narcotics sales recently and our guys have been doing an excellent job of identifying and arresting these people.

# December 2016

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from December 1st through December 31st, 2016.

During the month of December the Police received 310 calls for service. We did receive, 5 Theft, 6 Domestic/Assault, 1 Fraud, and 10 traffic collision calls. We wrote 92 citations.

The Police Department filed 30 charges including 13 for Narcotics Possession, 2 for DUI, 1 for Assault and 7 for Theft.

In December any and all certifications that needed to be completed were done. Myself and the supervisor set up a training schedule for next year. You will receive my yearly report at the next council meeting which will outline our 2016 statistics as well as any new ideas for 2017.

# HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT YEARLY REPORT FOR 2016

This is the yearly report for the Hellertown Police Department for 2016.

In 2016 the police department received 4603 calls for service, averaging approximately 13 calls per day. This is about the same number of calls received in 2015. We did receive 3 Sexual Assault, 48 Theft, 82 Domestic/Assault, 17 Fraud, 8 Burglary, 1 Attempted Robbery, 1 Firearms and 1 Motor Vehicle Theft calls. We had 154 traffic collisions and wrote 1,161 citations. All of these numbers have become normal for us in the past few years. I don't feel, as far as calls for service, that we saw any significant increases in anything other than traffic collisions, which increased 20%. Obviously we have continuously had an increase in traffic each year so this increase would follow along. We did however see a decrease of 32% in our theft calls. It is difficult to pinpoint an exact reason for the decrease, but I would contribute some of it to the fact that we closed, by arrest, 81% of our theft calls last year. I do feel that people who commit these types of crimes tend to stay away from areas where there is a good likelihood they will be caught. Our guys did a fantastic job of making arrests in theft cases for 2016, 81% is almost double the national average.

The Police Department filed 360 charges in 2016. This is almost the exact same number of charges filed in 2015. Although the number of charges is about the same, we did see significant increases in certain areas. We filed 62 DUI, 148 Narcotics, 6 Possession With the Intent to Deliver Narcotics, 14 Assault, 39 Theft, 7 Fraud/Forgery, 3 Sexual Assault, 1 Burglary and 4 Firearms related charges in 2016. We did see an increase in the number of firearms related charges, which is always troublesome. Our number of DUI arrests increased 24%, our Narcotics Possession charges increased 30% and we had 6 PWI charges in 2016. As everyone reads in the paper narcotics are becoming rampant everywhere. We do a great job in our fight against the increase, especially in the area of PWI. People charged with PWI are basically the people in our town who sell drugs. PWI cases are lengthy and take a lot of man hours to investigate. These cases can span across our county as well as other counties and even states. We do utilize our county task force when investigating some of these cases simply because, in conjunction with HPD, it gives us greater manpower. In 2016 we did a great job on all of our PWI cases and we are working hard to keep these people out of our town.

In 2016 we conducted multiple tours of our department and equipment for local organizations such as the boy scouts and girl scouts, Sgt. Johnston installed 27 car seats for residents, we participated in Catholic Schools week by attending lunch with the kids at St. Theresa's, we had our annual tent at Community Day, did our normal participation in the Halloween Parade and our vehicle and bike patrol officers were out during trick or treat handing out glow necklaces and bracelets to kids. We also teamed up with 7-11 and participated Operation Chill, where officers hand out coupons for free slurpee's to kids who are observed doing something good.

Once again we had many officers attend trainings in 2016. Training is always a point of emphasis so officers can continuously learn new ways to police. All of our officers attended our yearly mandatory updates through MPOETC, our yearly defensive tactics training and our, twice a year, firearms qualifications and training. Detective Dattilio and Corporal Donato are our firearms instructors and have been doing an excellent job. We have seen our average qualification scores increase dramatically over the past few years. We have also been utilizing our Force on Force simunitions weapons, that we bought through a casino grant, during defensive tactics training. The officers have nothing but good things to say about the weapons, specifically how realistic they are. All officers also recertified in SFST and DUI checkpoint training. Corporal Donato attended a Tactical Communications training as well as a state inspection training, both taught by PSP. Officer Szmodis attended the same state inspection training. Officer Fischer recertified as a drug recognition expert and officer Andree recertified as our CLEAN/TAC officer. Corporal Donato and Officer Fischer attended a training to become armorers for our new AR-15's and Corporal Donato also attended a high impact supervision training taught by Penn State University. We also implemented the carrying and use of NARCAN last year and all of our officers completed the training to be certified. We used NARCAN 10 times in 2016 and all 10 uses were successful.

We will once again conduct yearly firearms and defensive tactics trainings in 2017 and all of our officers will attend mandatory updates. As of now I also have Officers Pfancook, Szmodis and Fouts attending a First Contact training and myself, Donato and Johnston attending an advanced media relations training taught by the Counter Terrorism Task Force.

We received multiple grants in 2016. We received our casino grant for the two officers, another casino grant to replace one of our older vehicles, a ballistic vest grant for bullet proof vests, a click-it-orticket grant, an aggressive driving grant and a grant to specifically target juveniles driving without seat belts.

We did our Junked and Abandoned vehicle initiative again in 2016 and found some vehicles not in compliance but as a whole residents are doing a good job inspecting and registering their vehicles. Once again we did an outstanding job investigating and prosecuting PWI cases in the borough. Corporal Donato did a great job working a stolen handgun case last year, it was a difficult case and some of the firearms were recovered by the Easton Police Department as well as the FBI. Detective Dattilio did a lot of work on the Copeman case, where he arrested Copeman for sexual abuse of children and he did another excellent job. Officer Fischer did a good job investigating a child abuse case and arrested the father for aggravated assault. Multiple officers also investigated a check fraud case in the borough and we did make two arrests in that case. Everything went pretty well in 2016 and we will be striving to make Hellertown a safer community in 2017!
