The Borough received a licensing agreement from SESAC that would require the borough to pay a licensing fee to copyrighted music. In my opinion, the musician's performing should be responsible for copyright issues since they are the ones performing the songs. I would recommend requesting proof of that when making a contract with the musicians to play the event. Mrs. Hartranft and I will work on further investigating.

3. Adoption of Resolution 17-06, Keystone Communities Program Grant Application for Dimmick Park Playground Upgrades- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- We did apply for this grant last year and we weren't chosen as a recipient. We were encouraged to apply again this year. The Borough is asking for \$178,000.00 toward Dimmick Park Playground upgrades.


