## VI. Courtesies of the Floor

### A. Pre-Scheduled Appearances

#### 1. Susan Ackermann- Presentation of Dimmick Park Bandshell Mural Proposal

Mrs. Ackermann provided Borough Council with a rendering of the proposed mural at the bandshell. The work is scheduled to begin in July and be completed by September. The artist did request that the area be powerwashed and a bonding agent be applied prior to him beginning the work. The plaques would be grouted and then covered with epoxy to withstand the elements.

Mr. Payung noted that he envisioned more landmarks being included.

Mrs. Ackermann- The Streestacks is representative of the large part the Bethlehem Steel played in Hellertown history. As far as the people, it was designed more to represent Concerts in the Park as this is being mostly funded by the Hellertown Enhancement Project.

Mr. Rieger did not get the feel from just looking at it that it represented the Music is the Park.

Mrs. Ackermann and Council discussed the potential changes with the artist via telephone conference. It was suggested to add the plaza fountain, athletics like the grandstand, include the bandshell itself, or perhaps use the park entrance sign.

Mrs. Ackermann will send pictures to the artist and he will provide a second proposal in a few weeks.

This item will be on the agenda for May 1, 2017.

2. Robin Rotherham- Presentation of Hellertown Area Library Annual Report

Mrs. Rotherham thanked Council and Public Works for their continued support.

Mrs. Rotherham- The library gained 470 new patrons in 2016. There has been a large increase in the use of the public work stations. We have improved the security and downloads are erased nightly. The security cameras have recently been installed. In the next 5-10 years, the library hopes to increase the collections and increase in size. Friends of the Hellertown Library have been doing most of the fundraising. Their next event will be June 17, 2017, at Lost Tavern Brewing.

The Library was recently awarded a Keystone Communities Grant for a new roof and stucco work to the building.

Motion made by Jonathan Lentz, seconded by Philip Weber, to adjourn to Executive Session at 7:53 p.m.


Mr. Corriere advised that the Executive Session is being held to discuss personnel matters and the purchase or lease of property.

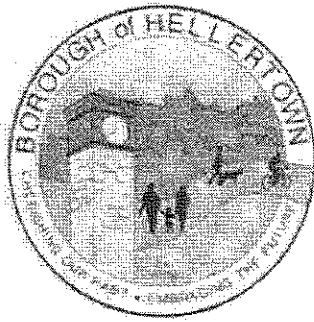
