Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Philip Weber, to approve the May 1, 2017, minutes as written. Motion carried 7-0.

VI. Courtesies of the Floor

A. Pre-Scheduled Appearances

1. Susan Ackermann- Presentation of Revised Dimmick Park Bandshell Mural Proposal

Ms. Ackermann presented the audience with a revised mural proposal and explained that the purchased memorial bricks will go in the painted asphalt area. The artist is expecting completion by the end of July or early August. He will coordinate with Public Works for any assistance that may be required.

2. Robert Grim and Kenny Rampolla, Lost Tavern Brewing- Discussion on 1st Anniversary Presentation

The Brewer's Guild Festival Meeting was rescheduled until after today, so we will come to the next meeting to discuss. We did preemptively speak with some neighbors and the doctor's office and no one had any issues.

July 1st will be our one-year anniversary. We would like to hold a celebratory event on our property. The parking lot would be closed for games, we would have additional food trucks, and music inside. Mr. Russo will forward a Special Event on Private Property form to them.

Lee Weidner requested that Council use their microphones as he has trouble hearing from the audience. He thanked Council for looking into the issue of pedestrian safety along Main Street. One suggestions was to install a "Yield to Pedestrian" sign on both sides of the roadway at Chestnut Street for crossing by the American Legion. He also urged residents to contact the state legislature and push for the use of radar by local police departments.

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Herbert Payung, to adjourn to Executive Session at 7:52 p.m. Motion carried 7-0.


Mr. Corriere advised that the Executive Session was being held to discuss personnel matters and possible litigation.

HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

March 2017

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from March 1st through March 31st, 2017.

During the month of March the Police received 431 calls for service. We did receive 11 Domestic/Assault, 1 Theft, 1 Fraud and 6 traffic collision calls. We wrote 156 citations.

The Police Department filed 14 charges including 6 for Narcotics Possession, 4 for DUI, and 2 for Theft.

In March our call volume was up a little for this month. We are about to start our junked and abandoned vehicle initiative in the borough under the new ordinance. We have been working on a few high priority narcotics investigations that you will probably see next month. Any questions feel free to stop in or call.

HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

April 2017

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from April 1st through April 30th, 2017.

During the month of April the Police received 404 calls for service. We did receive 1 Theft, 8 Domestic/Assault, 1 Burglary, and 9 traffic collision calls. We wrote 111 citations.

The Police Department filed 42 charges including 18 for Narcotics Possession, 6 for Possession with the Intent to Deliver Narcotics, 8 for DUI, 2 for Burglary and 3 for Theft.

In the month of April our call volume was once again increased. Our Narcotics and DUI arrests were definitely increased compared to last year and as you can tell by the 6 PWI arrests, we wrapped up the larger narcotics investigation we were working on. We did raid two houses, 404 Main Street and 39 Kiernan Ave, where the occupants were selling Methamphetamine and Heroin. The officers did a great job on both of these cases. We also are in the early stages of our crosswalk assessment's, we have been doing studies at our busiest crosswalks and will be starting our enforcement after I meet with all of you and the planning commission.
