1. Outstanding Obligations- Approval of Payments

Authorization to Advertise Ordinance 820, Amendments to Zoning Ordinance- Council Action

Mr. Smith- This ordinance removes the minimum parking requirement for drive-thru banks, addresses the removal of parking restrictions on Durham Street, and to provide a 30 day enforcement notice appeal period.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to authorize the advertisement of Ordinance 820. Motion carried 6-0.

 Approval and Authorization to Advertise Budget Meeting Dates-Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- I have proposed October 2, October 9, October 16, October 23, and October 30 as budget meeting dates. Meetings would begin at 6:00 p.m. and the last two dates would be as needed.

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Philip Weber.

Mr. Rieger- I would like to invite Kevin Lott, David Heintzelman, and Gil Stauffer to sit in on the budget meetings.

Motion carried 6-0.

4. Authorization to Bid for Recycling Services- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- Our recycling contract with J.P. Mascaro expires December 2017.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Earl Hill, to authorize the advertisement of the Recycling Bid for 2018. Motion carried 6-0.

 Adoption of Amendment to Safety & Health Manual Section 3.3
 Working In Permit Required Confined Spaces; Adding Sections 3.3.5
 (Entering Splash Pad Sump Pump Pit) and 3.3.6 (Entering the Borough Hall French Drain Sump Pit)- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- These changes were recommended by DVWIT.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Philip Weber, to approve the changes to the Safety & Health Manual. Motion carried 6-0.

6. Approval of TASA Application and Borough Match for Un-Signalized Intersection and Crosswalk Improvements- Council Action

Mr. Smith- This is a grant opportunity for crosswalk improvements. The amount we are seeking is \$992,427.00. That covers 100 percent of the construction cost and 15 percent for inspections. The application goes through two reviews: one by the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission and another by the State if approved by LVPC. The State will be distributing three years of allocations. LVPC will be awarding two years of allocations. The Borough would need to contribute around \$98,000.00 at the most for engineering services. It is hard to find grants to just fund engineering costs but we can try to get grants to reduce it by approximately one-third.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve the grant application and Borough match.

Mrs. Hartranft- We will discuss the Borough allocation further during the budget sessions.

Motion carried 6-0.

7. Adoption of Resolution 17-18, Authorizing Grant Request to Monroe County LSA for Main Street Pedestrian Crossing Improvements-Council Action

Mr. Smith- This resolution is requesting a Monroe County Gaming Grant in the amount of \$302,232.00 for pedestrian improvements at Thomas and Hampton Streets.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to adopt Resolution 17-18. Motion carried 6-0.

8. Authorization to Share Cost of Turface Product on East End Field

Mr. Rieger- We have been asked to share the cost of putting Turface on the East End Field. The Borough would be responsible \$1,850.00. The product helps to absorb water on the field. There are funds in the Parks budget to cover the cost.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to approve the contribution toward using the Truface on the East End Field. Motion carried 6-0.

9. Authorization to Release Remaining Escrow for Guru Land Development Project- Council Action

Mr. Smith- The 18-month warranty period is complete.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Michael McKenna, to release the escrow. Motion carried 6-0.

10. Authorization to Release Escrow for Casey Williams- Council Action

Mr. Smith noted that the work was complete.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to release the escrow. Motion carried 6-0.

11. Discussion on Offering of Old Holiday Decorations

Mrs. Hartranft- We have received requests from people who donated money for the old holiday decorations to have them back. I am looking for Council direction on what to do with the rest of the unclaimed decorations.

Mr. Weber- I feel the people who bought them should get them back if they want them.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to offer the lights back to the purchaser and revisit the issue at a later date after seeing how many are left. Motion carried 6-0.

12. Notification of Individual NPDES Permit Renewal Application by H. Blinderman & Sons

Mrs. Hartranft- We are being provided the renewal application because the business is within our municipality.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Earl Hill, to support the NPDES renewal. Motion carried 6-0.

13. Discussion on Media Agreement with Big 10 Network and Borough of Hellertown

Mr. Payung- The Big 10 Network is doing a segment on Saquon Barkley and would like to film Ed Kolosky about a 2015 Track and Field story. At the time, Mr. Barkley was attending Whitehall School District. They would like to use Dimmick Park. The filming would be done tomorrow around 7:00 a.m. They have provided an agreement.

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Michael McKenna, to authorize the execution the media agreement with the Big 10 Network. Motion carried 6-0.
