A. Treasurer

Motion made Michael McKenna, seconded by Philip Weber, to receive the September 2017 Treasurer's Reports. Motion carried 7-0.

B. Engineer

Mr. Smith was not present for the meeting but sent a report.

Mrs. Hartranft- The contact is continuing the work on the bridge projects. The pointing of the Front Street Bridge is about complete. The work under the bridges is continuing. Curb and sidewalks are being replaced at Delaware, Northampton, and Rentzheimer bridges. It is anticipated that a majority of the work will be completed this fall.

The Water Street pedestrian/bicycle safety project will replace the current advance warning flashers shared with the Heller Homestead, with rapid flashers at either side of the trail crossing. Since the Rail Trail and Hellertown Homestead trail crossing in Lower Saucon share the same advance warning light system, PennDOT would not permit upgrading the rail trail without Lower Saucon making a similar change at their crossing. Lower Saucon has agreed to participate in the project and pay for the rapid flashers at the Heller Homestead crossing. Both crossings will have upgraded signals next year.

C. Solicitor

Mr. Corriere- The attorney for BT STonewood noted that her client is out of town but should hear back from her shortly about the agreement. I would like Council to give Mr. Rieger permission to execute the agreement with solicitor's approval and after all bills have been paid.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Philip Weber, to authorization execution of the new agreement with all fees paid and documents completed. Motion carried 7-0.

X. New Business

1. Outstanding Obligations- Approval of Payments

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve the payments. Motion carried 6-0 (James Hill abstained).

2. Adoption of Advertise Ordinance 820, Amendments to Zoning Ordinance- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- This ordinance was duly advertised.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to adopt Ordinance 820. Motion carried 7-0.

3. Adoption of Resolution 17-19, Execution of Sidewalk Maintenance Agreement with PennDOT for Water Street Bridge- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- Council already executed the agreement but PennDOT is also requesting a resolution.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Earl Hill, to adopt Resolution 17-19. Motion carried 7-0.

4. Approval of the 2018-2020 Public Works Collective Bargaining Agreement- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- This contract is for three years. There is a 2.75 percent raise per year, the designation of a crew leader when the Public Works Director is absent, two hour minimum call out time, and \$100.00 increase in employer contribution to employee pension plan. Lastly, there will be a 6.5 percent employee contribution toward the health care plan in 2018, 7.0 percent in 2019, and 7.5 percent in 2020.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve the 2018-2020 Public Works Bargaining Agreement. Motion carried 7-0.

5. Authorizing the Purchase of 2017 Case Model 621G XT Loader Per Costars Quote Dated 9/8/17- Council Action

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve the purchase of 2017 Case Loader for \$116,500.00, which includes a trade-in amount of \$27,000 for the current loader. Funds will be taken from the Capital Budget. Motion carried 7-0.

6. Authorizing the Extension of the Improvements Agreement for 30-32 Clarke Street- Council Action

Mr. Russo- Currently, Council granted an extension for this project until summer 2018. They are requesting an additional extension. Another addendum will need to be completed and more funds would need to be contributed to their escrow account.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve the extension. Motion carried 7-0.

7. Approval of Special Event Request for Cub Scout Fall Event, October 21-22, 2017- Council Action

Motion made by Earl Hill, seconded by Michael McKenna, to adopt Approve the Special Event Request for Cub Scout Fall Event contingent upon receipt of Indemnification. Motion carried 7-0.

8. Approval of Request for Handicap Parking Space at 59 Bachman Street- Council Action

Motion made by Herbert Payung, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve the handicap parking space at 59 Bachman Street. Motion carried 7-0.

9. Approval of Façade Improvement Grant Application for 628 Main Street in the Amount of \$4,498.78- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- The Planning Commission reviewed this application at their last meeting. They were against the idea of painting the entire façade. The applicant then went out and got a proposal for acid washing instead. The Planning Commission was fine with their application for a new awning, painting the decorative features of the building, and new window signage. The update grant will be \$5,061.00.

Mr. Weber- The Planning Commission is fine with the cost increase.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Earl Hill, to approve the façade improvement grant application for 628 Main Street in the amount of \$5,061.00 based on the recommendation of the Planning Commission. Motion carried 7-0.



# HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

## September 2017

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from September 1st through September 30th, 2017.

During the month of September the Police received 356 calls for service. We did receive 2 Forgery/Fraud, 1 Theft, 9 Assault/Domestic, 3 Sex Assault, 1 Motor Vehicle Theft and 16 traffic collision calls. We wrote 127 citations.

The Police Department filed 28 charges including 8 for Narcotics Possession, 3 for DUI, 5 for Assault and 11 Other Criminal Charges.

A lot of time was spent last month preparing for our fall firearms and tactics trainings as well as preparing the 2018 budget. We will be participating in the annual Spirit Parade as well as Trick or Treat. We will have 2 bike officers as well as the normal patrol officers out during trick or treat handing out glow necklaces and bracelets. Our weights and measures officer has been doing a good job of targeting CDL vehicles with major violations and getting those truck off the road.
