C. Solicitor

Mr. Corriere- I am working on amending the zoning ordinance to include a savings clause for conditional use. I will have for staff review later this week.

The Planning Commission reviewed the Saucon Valley Manor site plan.

Mr. McKenna inquired about adding an additional fee to cover the cost of the Borough Authority doing the PA1 Call.

Mr. Corriere advised that the fee is limited to the cost of road repair.

F. Public Works Director

Mr. Henshaw- If we get the winter weather that they are anticipating, the compost center will not be open on Saturday.

Bethlehem has offered us their screener at no cost. It is need of some repair. The cost will be a minimum of \$1,000.00. We are currently paying \$6,000.00, per year to get the material screened. We are looking to partner with Lower Saucon Township and share in the repair costs.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by John Bate, to authorize the delivery of the screener. Motion carried 6-0.

Mrs. Hartranft- The personnel on the call-out list for plowing would be treated as seasonal employees. They would be paid at a rate of \$15.00.

Mr. Bate recommended that sanitation crew be moved to plow and that garbage be collected on a different day.

Motion made by John Bate, seconded by Herbert Payung, to allow Mrs. Hartranft and staff to compile a call-out list. Motion carried 6-0.

G. Zoning/Codes Officer

4. Discussion on Zimpfer Lane No Parking from East Side of Driveway Opening at 1523 Zimpfer Lane South 63 Feet

Mrs. Hartranft- Staff has been looking into putting a "no parking" zone at 1523 Zimpfer Lane. It is tough for larger vehicles to maneuver in the area if a car is parked there. The owner of the property is currently looking into widening the driveway apron so his vehicles will be off the road. He is meeting the contractor tomorrow.

Mr. Henshaw- The Fire Department, Sanitation Department, UPS, and USPS have all made complaints about navigating the area.

Motion made by Herbert Payung to present as presented. Motion died due to a lack of a second.

This matter was tabled until the February 1, 2016, meeting to allow the property owner time to meet with the contractor about the driveway expansion.

5 Discussion and Approval of Quote for Bullet Resistant Transaction Window for Borough Hall Lobby- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- Our Workers' Compensation Company suggested that the window in the front lobby be replaced with bullet resistant glass. We received a quote for \$4,632.00. We would be eligible for a grant of \$3,000.00 and the remaining \$1,632.00 would be taken from building capital. The window will be moveable if any renovations are done to the building. Mr. Rieger would also like staff to look into getting a keypad entry for the office door.

Motion made by Michael McKenna, seconded by Herbert Payung, to accept as presented and have staff obtain a quote for the keypad lock for the February 1, 2016, meeting.

Mr. Bate also recommended looking at putting a keypad lock at the top of the stairs to the second floor.

Motion carried 5-1 (Mr. James Hill opposed).

Mayor Fluck will look into having full police coverage at all Council meetings.
