Borough of Hellertown Council Meeting Minutes Monday, April 18, 2016

A PUBLIC HEARING WAS HELD PRIOR TO THE COUNCIL MEETING AT 6:30 P.M. TO DISUCSS CABLE FRANCHISE RENEWALS

The public hearing was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Mr. Rieger- This hearing is being held pursuant to Section 626 of the Federal Cable Act, which sets forth the process for franchise renewal. The Borough's current franchises with RCN and Service Electric will expire in the near term, and the Borough is beginning the process of renewing the franchises. This public hearing is part of the preliminary portion of franchise renewal in which the Borough reviews the cable operators' past performance and identifies the Borough's future cable-related community needs. As such, as part of this public hearing, we invite comments from any citizens who wish to speak regarding either or both of the aforementioned subjects. Franchise renewal is the best opportunity for municipalities to assert their rights with respect to their cable operators and to obtain important benefits in return for granting the cable operators the right to use their public right-of-ways. These benefits include a State-of-the- Art Cable System now and in the future, strong customer service standards, free services to community facilities, better reporting requirements from the cable operators, maximized franchise fees, and educational and governmental channel, legal protections of the Right-of-Way, and better mechanisms to enforce the franchise agreements. These are just some of the benefits available through franchise renewal. Citizens may address these items or any other cable-related items that are important to them. We will now open the hearing up to citizen comments.

Mr. Bate inquired when RCN will repair properties that were damaged when underground lines were installed on Ilona Drive and Zimpfer Lane.

Ann-Marie Gonsalves inquired why the service costs keep increasing fort basic cable.

Mr. Bate questioned if the Borough has been contacted about FIOS coming to the area.

Mr. Payung noted that the Lehigh Valley does not have the infrastructure to support FIOS yet.

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There being no further questions or comments, the public hearing was closed at 6:37 p.m.

2. Adoption of Ordinance 805, Amendments to the Zoning Ordinance-Council Action

Mr. Corriere- This amendment puts a safety clause in place for conditional use. Also included is a Bed and Breakfast being a permitted use in the Town Center and Trail Overlay Districts with a maximum of four rooms. A Bed and Breakfast is considered a conditional use in the Shopping Center, Conservation, and Mixed Districts with a maximum of eight room.

Mrs. Hartranft- This amendment was reviewed by the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission and Hellertown Planning Commission.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by Herbert Payung, to adopt Ordinance 805. Motion carried 7-0.

3. Adoption of Ordinance 806, Amending Chapter 1 of the Code of Ordinance- Council Action

Mr. Corriere- This amendment allows for the cost, fees, and penalties, to be made by resolution rather than amending the ordinance.

Motion made by Herbert Payung, seconded by Philip Weber, to adopt Ordinance 806. Motion carried 6-1 (Mr. James Hill opposed).

4. Discussion on Repairs to Maple/Willow Road Drainage Swale

Mr. Smith- There is a drainage swale between Maple and Willow Roads. There is noted erosion and the concrete baffles are no longer in place. I would recommend using special fabric and grass. Blacktop will accelerate the water and create a higher velocity.

Mr. Weber suggested the use of cablecrete which would slow the water down and be anchored to the ground.

Mr. Payung- Are residents dumping in the swale?

Mr. Henshaw- Yes. It is mostly yard waste.

Mr. Rieger- I would like to revisit this matter at the next meeting and have Mr. Smith look into other options.

Approval of Request for Escrow Reduction for 708 Main Street-Council Action

Mr. Smith- The developer is seeking a reduction in escrow. \$83,795.80 worth of work has been completed. After the 15 percent is retained, they will receive \$71,226.17.

Motion made by Philip Weber, seconded by John Bate, to approve the escrow reduction. Motion carried 6-0 (Mr. Rieger abstained).
