Chief Shupp- My idea was to require a yearly permit be obtained to be allowed to tarp a vehicle.

Mr. Rieger- We would also require them to provide a license and registration on the permit.

Chief Shupp- I would also like a requirement added that the vehicles must be kept in a driveway and not parked on grass.

HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT May 2016

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from May 1st through May 31st, 2016.

During the month of May the Police received 442 calls for service. We did receive 4 Theft, 8 Domestic/Assault, 3 Fraud, 1 Sex Assault and 11 traffic collision calls. We wrote 155 citations.

The Police Department filed 25 charges including 8 for Narcotics Possession, 5 for DUI, 2 for Assault, 4 for Theft, 1 for Forgery and 2 Firearms charges.

Our call volume is rising, as expected with summer approaching. We are currently working on a theft of firearms case in town where four guns were stolen. We were advised by the Easton Police Department and the FBI that they did recover one of the handguns during a raid in Easton. We have developed a suspect in the case and will be filing charges. We have made 4 saves using our Narcan kits, all of which involved Heroin use. Any questions or concerns feel free to call or stop by.
