### B. Engineer

Mr. Smith- Mrs. Hartranft, the inspector from Barry Isett & Associates, and myself met with the contractor for the ADA Ramp project. All curbs that did not meet specification were marked and will be removed. The contractor has also changed to double mix concrete and hired a new finisher. There is about 2 ½ weeks of work left. I also looked into the liquid coming from their machinery in the parking lot. It is not oil but rather water resulting from condensation in the air conditioning of the machinery..

The Dimmick Park Bandshell and pool decks have been resurfaced.

### C. Solicitor

Mr. Corriere- The Improvements and Maintenance Agreements have been sent to 33 Penn Street.

It was discovered that the Library has stocks that they wanted to cash in and they had asked both solicitors to sign off on them. The solicitor cannot do that as the power is vested in the Board of Trustees. They will also need to look into any effect cashing in the stocks would have on their 501c status.

Motion made by John Bate, seconded by Joseph Pampanin, to forward Solicitor's Opnion letter to the Library Board of Trustees. Motion carried 7-0.

Mr. McKenna inquired how Council was not made aware to the shares during the merger.

Mr. Rieger- They are their own entity so Council does not have much say. Since we do contribute, I feel that we should ask to see a copy of their audit on a yearly basis.

Mr. Payung noted that a lot of items have been discovered in the three years since the merger.

### 2. Announcement of Fall Yard Waste Pickup

Mr. Henshaw announced that the Fall Yard Waste Pickup will be held the week of September 28th on the residents' normal garbage day. Mr. Henshaw- UGI has delayed the start of our roadwork. A large pipe was replaced on Riegel Street. AMS is on standby and will begin work as soon as UGI has completed their work.

We are beginning to have issues with residents racking leaves out into the street and gutter. The leaf schedule does not start until November 2, 2015. The Compost Center is open for drop-offs.

Lastly, there have been multiple portable baskeball hoops in the streets. I spoke with Chief Shupp and there is nothing on the books that mentions them and I would like Council to look into getting it specifically mentioned in the ordinance.

### 2. Discussion on Sanitation/Recycling Issue on Courtright Street

Mr. Russo- I received a letter from a resident who lives on Courtright Street. The land was subdivided in 1984 and she has been maintaining the back property and uses the property to walk her garbage up the Keilman Street where it is picked up. Now that parcel is being developed and the owner is not sure that he will allow her to walk through is property. An easement needs to be made for water and sewer. She does not have other options as the properties on either side have fenced in yards. A garbage truck cannot pickup on Courtright due to parking on both sides.

Mr. Rieger- I would hope that this could be worked out between the parties. If not, she can always get private counsel. In the meantime, the Borough might need to send a pickup truck to get her garbage once a week.

2. 2016 Non-Uniform Employees' Pension Plan Minimum Municipal Obligation- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- The minimum municipal obligation for the Non-Uniform Employees is \$21,450.00. This is covered by employees' 3.6 percent contribution.

3. 2016 Uniform Employees' Pension Plan Minimum Municipal Obligation- Council Action

Solicitor Corriere- The 2016 minimum municipal obligation for the Uniformed Employees is \$46,456.76. This amount is covered by state aid.

Motion made by John Bate, seconded by Herbert Payung, to approve the 2016 Minimum Municipal Obligation for Uniformed Employees. Motion carried 7-0.

### 4. Discussion on Vehicular Weight Study

Mr. Smith- Barry Isett & Associates a weight study of E. High Street, Linden Avenue, and Northampton Street. As part of the study, we conducted a crash analysis, geometric study, pavement testing, speed calculation, and traffic volume county. There were no incidents regarding large vehicles on any of the tested streets. No street had ideal unrestricted egress. The pavement does not substantiate heavy traffic. The average speed is between 25-30 m.p.h. Linden Street had a few tractor trailers but the other two had no truck traffic.

We would recommend a weight limit of 6 tons. Local deliveries will be permitted. Signage would be required at Cherry Lane and the Borough will need to amend the ordinance.

Motion made by Michel McKenna, seconded by Joseph Pampanin, to begin the process of amending the ordinance. Motion carried 6-1 (Mr. McKenna opposed).

5. Approval of Request for Donation from Hellertown-Lower Saucon Veterans Memorial Association to Enlarge Veteran Memorial- Council Action

Mr. Rieger- This would be for enlarging the veterans' wall at the Union Cemetery.

Motion made by Michael McKenna to table this request and direct staff to find out what kind of a donation they are seeking. Motion carried 7-0.
