VI. Courtesies of the Floor

A. Pre-Scheduled Appearances

1. Erin Siegfried, Saucon Valley Community Center Update

Walter Morrissey, Erin Siegfried, Jenny McKenna, and Jim Zawick were all present. They discussed various programs for youth and seniors and their fundraising efforts. The Community Center is part of the Amazonsmile program and also the Giant A+ Program.

Dave Spirk- Overview of Silver Creek Country Club Development Proposal

Mr. Spirk representing Silver Land Group LLC in conjunction with Silver Creek Country Club intends to build approximately 124 country club townshouses on three proposed tracts. The Club encompasses 280+ acres. The proposed tracts aggregate approximately 30 acres. The Club land is currently zoned as single family residential on one-acre sites.

Jim Preston- A majority will be built in Lower Saucon Township which it will require an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance to maximize coverage of a cluster development of townhouses on three tracts. The owners of the townhouses will be required to be members of the golf course.

Scott Mease- There will be three pods of townhouses. The southern section will have 47 townhouses and is accessible from Reservoir Road. The other module will have 48 units and will be accessible from Wassergass Road and Durham Street. The last module will have 28 units and is accessible from Apple Street and New Jersey Avenue. All roadways will be private and the water and sewer will be provided by the Hellertown Borough Authority.

Chief Shupp inquired if the 124 units have all been designed. Mr. Spirk noted that there are currently 30 presales but all the homes with be custom built.

Mr. Payung brought up his concerns for stormwater management. Mr. Mease said the plan would include infiltration and draingage pipes. Per law, we cannot increase run-off past the preconstruction run-off.

Earl Hill requested that the Engineer keep in close contact regarding stormwater maintenance so that there aren't further issues with flooding in Hellertown.

Kate Griffiths, 1354 New Jersey Avenue- What will happen to the additional acreage that is not proposed to be preserved should the country club go out of business.

Mr. Spirk- Currently under the Lower Saucon Township Zoning Ordinance, I could build 150 single family homes. We are trying to minimize the impact on the golf course and give them the best shot to stay in business.

Mr. Preston- All owners of the units will be voting members of the country club and I'm sure they would vote for what is best for the association and golf course.

Ms. Griffiths- Which section of units will be built first?

Mr. Preston- That decision will be based on presales but it will probably be the southern module.

Mr. Payung inquired if all units will be sold in presale or will some remain unfinished.

Mr. Spirk noted that all homes will be sold in presale.

Council thanked the representatives and would like the opportunity to review the plan upon formal submission to Lower Saucon Township.

4. Approval of Joint Agreement with Lower Saucon Township to have Barry Isett & Associates Complete a Traffic Study Review for LVIP VII- Council Action

Mrs. Hartranft- Hanover Engineering is the engineer for both LVIP and Lower Saucon Township so they felt it was a conflict to both represent Lower Saucon and represent LVIP VII and have asked Barry Isett & Associates to compete the joint review. The cost is \$4,500.00 to be split between Lower Saucon Township and Hellertown Borough.

7. Approval of Handicap Parking Space Request for 1431 Keilman Avenue- Council Action

Chief Shupp- Both Mr. Henshaw and myself went to look at the area. The homeowner does have a garage and a driveway however, it does meet all the requirements per our ordinance.

Mr. Henshaw- Council has never approved a handicap parking space for a home that has off-street parking and a garage. Keilman Avenue also has limited parking due to parking being restricted on one side.
