#### HELLERTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT MONTHLY REPORT

### October 2018

This is the monthly report for the Hellertown Police Department from October 1st through October 31st, 2018.

During the month of October the Police received 338 calls for service. We did receive 1 Forgery/Fraud, 4 Theft, 9 Domestic/Assault, 1 Sex Offense, 2 Robbery / Attempted Robbery and 17 traffic collision calls. We wrote 101 citations.

The Police Department filed 40 charges including 10 for Narcotics Possession, 3 for DUI, 5 for Assault, 4 for Theft, 8 for Robbery / Attempted Robbery, 1 for Sexual Assault and 1 for Fleeing and Eluding a police officer.

As of the end of the month the Police have completed all necessary training requirements for the year and we are now working on setting up all training for next year. The Halloween parade was a great success again this year, we had 2 vehicles and 2 bike officer in the parade. Trick or Treat was also a great success and we received no calls for criminal mischief. The officers had another outstanding month in regards to criminal arrests, as you can see by the numbers above. Corporal Donato did an excellent job on a Robbery case we received. As of the end of October we have made 14 more arrests than the entire year of 2017. The guys have been doing an outstanding job. Any questions please feel free to stop in or call.
