Mr. Corriere- The liens typically stay with the property until it is sold. The Borough could request the Northampton County Sheriff's Office hold a Sheriff's Sale of the property and hope that the home sells so the lien can be paid. The fee upfront to order the sale is \$2,500.00 and it would have to be advertised. I would recommend Council

create a policy outlining the criteria for a lien to be sent to Sheriff's Sale.

Mrs. Hartranft- Including attorney's fees, the outstanding liens total about \$186,000.00.
